What levels of service are offered?

Slingshot service is available free for 30 days. Multiple plans are available based on customer needs. Pricing information is available at slingshotapp.com.

What devices can share a screen?

Any Mac® or PC running Slingshot can screen share. Most iOS® devices can share screens, too! Even more devices support viewing and collaboration. For a full and complete list of supported devices visit <http://slingshotapp.com>.

Are there Slingshot alternatives?

While other solutions exist, no other product can share mobile device screens. Slingshot is the first product that allows screen sharing from a mobile device while meeting with others online.

What is Meeting Minutes?

Meeting Minutes is a collaborative way to keep track of and organize meetings. Anyone in a session can contribute to Meeting Minutes, and changes will be seen by all users in real time.

How many screens can be shared?

Only one screen can be shared at a time. That includes mobile devices, tablets and computers.

When will Slingshot be available?

Slingshot will be publicly available on May 1, 2014.

Who should use Slingshot?

How are Slingshot users billed?

Most users are billed on a monthly recurring cycle. Depending on the original signup method, this may be through credit card or in-app purchase. Some users may be billed annually depending on their plan.
