OR

Five years of full-time, professional supply management experience (nonclerical, nonsupport) without a
qualified bachelor's degree

AND

• Successfully pass three CPSM® Exams, OR, if you are a C.P.M. in good standing, pass the Bridge Exam

Recertify every three years with 60 Continuing Education Hours (CEHs). For added convenience, ISM offers many online courses to earn CEHs, including free web seminars.
