Canowindra, NSW, Australia | A Brief History

The Charles McCarron Baths (now Canowindra) were opened 60 years ago in New South Wales, Australia by the Cabonne Shire Council. The original complex featured a 33 meter outdoor pool. Over time the pool had deteriorated and was on the verge of shutdown until it was decided a renovation would take place in 2013.

Canowindra Pool Today

The Charles McCarron Baths, now known as the Canowindra Pool Complex celebrated its sixtieth year with a grand reopening and a renovation project. The project converted the 33 meter pool into a 25 meter lap pool, added a children's program pool with a beach style entry and water features, computerized timing equipment, solar



heating and a state of the art pump and filtration technology for the pools.

The facility's renovation was designed and contructed by the award-winning Beau



Corp Aquatics of Queensland Australia.
