

The YMCA and Carowinds Team Up to Reinforce the Importance of Learning to Swim and Reward Kids for Practicing Water Safety

The University City YMCA partners with Carowinds to provide free swim lessons to a select group of kids.

"We are grateful to our friends at Carowinds for allowing the Y to celebrate the addition of these new slides in a way that highlights the joy of swimming and <u>water safety</u> for kids and families."
