

VJ Books Presents Author Karin Slaughter

Karin Slaughter grew up in a small south Georgia town and has been writing novels and short stories since she was a child. She debuted with her novel *Blindsighted* in 2001, becoming an international success and making the Dagger Award shortlist for "Best Thriller Debut" of 2001.

Slaughter is best known for her Grant County series which is set in the fictional town of Heartsdale, Georgia, (in the fictional Grant County). The narrative takes place from the perspective of three main characters: Sara Linton, the town's pediatrician and part-time coroner; her ex-husband, Jeffrey Tolliver, who is chief of police; and his subordinate, detective Lena Adams, Slaughter's most controversial character.

The Will Trent series, which takes place in Atlanta, features special Agent Will Trent with the GBI and his partner Faith Mitchell. In summer 2009, Undone (called "Genesis" in the UK and elsewhere) merged the Grant County series with the Will Trent series.
