PRODUCT WARRANTIES

Standard Warranty: Depot warranty includes 90 days minimum on computer components, one year on refurbished Sun workstations and servers, and two years on Sun Embedded or custom workstations and servers. This warranty includes telephone technical support and defective part replacement. Technical and RMA department telephone assistance is available between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. (Eastern Standard Time), Monday through Friday, excluding Computer Connection of Central New York, Inc. holidays. Exception to the depot warranty is equipment offered on an "as is" basis.

Extended Warranty: An extended warranty is available and may be purchased at the time of sale, during, or at the end of an existing warranty time period. The extended warranty period must be purchased in 12-month increments.

Out of Warranty Repair: If a defective part or system is no longer within the established warranty period, Computer Connection of Central New York, Inc. shall charge a nominal fee for evaluation and repair of the reported problem. Any replacement or additional parts needed for a successful repair shall be billed to the customer. Customers will be given a quote on repair costs prior to a repair being completed.

Over the past year we have been working towards becoming R2 Certified in eWaste recycling. What the R2 Certification signifies is that our company works by a standard set of guidelines and procedures set forth to ensure environmental as well as general health safety of recycled equipment. Everything that we do, the people that we educate internally or externally and the procedures that we instill are completely documented at our facility and are under continual review.





History About the R2 Standard

The R2 standard is a comprehensive certification program created by the <u>United States Environmental Protection Agency</u>, State regulatory agencies, current electronics recyclers / refurbishers / trade associations, and original equipment manufacturers. Once the standard was completed it was then approved by the <u>ANAB</u> (ANSI-ASQ National Accreditation Board), which is an organization that provides accreditation to the certification bodies that conduct third party audits of electronics facilities.

With this certification we'll also become ISO 14001:2004 compliant and will be considered an environmentally responsible handler of recycled equipment.

Our Registrar



Perry Johnson Registrars, Inc. is a full-service registrar that carries <u>multiple international accreditations</u>. This means PJR has the authority to register organizations, recognizing them for their quality management system's integrity. We have been working with them from the very beginning and have utilized them to ensure that our process is completely that of the R2 Standard.

Drive Sanitation & Data Destruction: Computer Connection of CNY, Inc. certifies that all drives and tapes received at our facility are sanitized or destroyed per your request. Written certification/documentation is then provided verifying this process for your records. Drives are wiped in accordance with all software piracy laws, and all personal, non-transferable, or propriety information is erased using Darik's Boot and Nuke (DBAN) V. 2.2.7 which utilizes a Department of Defense 7 Pass Wiping Method. All of our drives are destructed using an Ameri-Shred Corp. Hard Drive Shredder (AMS 100/150 HD Series). All unrecoverable assets are recycled according to specifications set out by the New York Department of Environmental Conservation and in compliance with all local, state, and federal regulations.
