1958	Sweden	Brazil-Sweden 5-2	Just Fontaine (France) (13 goals)	126	16	First time soccer legend Pelé plays. Only player to have won 3 times. (1958, 1962, 1970) First time that World Cup matches are televised internationally
1962	Chile	Brazil-Czechoslovakia 3-1	Manuel Francisco dos Santos "Garrincha" (Brazil), Edvaldo Izídio Neto "Vavá" (Brazil), Leonel Sánchez (Chile), Dražan Jerković (Yugoslavia), Flórián Albert (Hungary), Valentin Ivanov (Soviet Union) (4 goals)	89	16	First Olympic Goal (direct goal from a corner kick) scored by Marcos Coll from Colombia England - First time goal average is used to determine advancement to the next round, eliminating Argentina
1966	England	England-West Germany 4-2	Eusébio da Silva Ferreira (Portugal) (9 goals)	89	16	World Cup Willie - First mascot introduced First time group draw is witnessed on TV

1974	West Germany	West Germany- Netherlands 2-1	Grzegorz Lato (Poland) (7 goals)	97	16	<p>First time the new "FIFA World Cup Trophy" is awarded to the champion</p> <p>First World Cup Final not played in the host's capital city</p>
1978	Argentina	Argentina-Netherlands 3-1	Mario Kempes (Argentina) (6 goals)	102	16	<p>First time over 100 countries attempt to qualify</p> <p>Penalty shootout is introduced (but not used) to determine the winning team if a match ends in a draw after overtime</p>
1982	Spain	Italy-West Germany 3-1	Paolo Rossi (Italy) (6 goals)	146	24	<p>First time countries from all 6 continental confederations participate - expanding from 16 to 24 teams</p> <p>West Germany vs France - First time penalty shootout takes place</p>
1986	Mexico	Argentina- West Germany 3-2	Gary Lineker (England) (6 goals)	132	24	<p>Mexico - the first country to host a World Cup twice</p> <p>Diego Maradona scores the infamous "Hand of God" goal' first and only hand goal</p>
1990	Italy	West Germany- Argentina 1-0	Salvatore Schillaci (Italy) (6 goals)	115	24	<p>Argentina - the first team to advance twice on penalty shootouts &amp; the first to not score any goals in a World Cup final</p> <p>First World Cup officially recorded and transmitted in HD by Italian broadcaster RAI</p>

2002	South Korea/Japan	Brazil- Germany 2-0	Ronaldo Luís Nazário de Lima (Brazil) (8 goals)	161	32	First time a World Cup is hosted in Asia and by 2 different countries First time teams from Europe, South America, North America, Asia and Africa reach the Quarter-Finals
2006	Germany	Italy-France 5-3	Miroslav Klose (Germany) (5 goals)	147	32	Lukas Podolski - First to receive "Best Young Player" Award Ronaldo from Brazil becomes the highest goal scorer in World Cup history with 15 goals
2010	South Africa	Spain- Netherlands 1-0	Thomas Müller (Germany), Wesley Sneijder (Netherlands), David Villa (Spain), Diego Forlán (Uruguay) (5 goals)	145	32	First World Cup to be hosted in African continent "Yashin Award", awarded to goalkeepers, was renamed to "Golden Glove Award"
