Opened in fall of 2012, our Cafayate winery has quickly become one of the premier wineries and tourist destinations in Salta, where only two percent of Argentine wine is produced. We are proud to introduce the world to the beautiful wines of this northerly sister region to Mendoza. The Cafayate Valley is ideal for grapevine cultivation, particularly the Queen of Argentine wines: Torrontés.

Our winery is one of the only gravity-flow vinification systems in Argentina. The system not only lends credence to our commitment to sustainable practices, but also maximizes flavor by preventing grapes from breaking prematurely, seeds from being crushed, and juice from being oxygenated and heated. The curved shape of our innovative concrete egg wine fermenters optimizes circulation and quality by forcing the juice, pulp, and skins into continuous contact throughout the fermentation process.

Located above 5,890 feet elevation, our Cafayate winery and 477 acres of vineyards represent an 80,000 case capacity and produces primarily Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon, Tannat, Cabernet Franc and Torrontés.

About Piattelli's Growing Regions

At Piattelli, we believe it is impossible to make worldclass wine without first beginning with world-class grapes. "The best technique in the world won't make up for an environment not perfectly suited to a given varietal," Piattelli Winemaker Valeria Antolin says.

We take great pride in crafting wines of place, where the atmosphere of Argentina gives grapes a growing advantage. The high, low-precipitation altitudes at our vineyards create a dry climate perfect for grape growth. The wide diurnal swings of warm days and cool nights stimulate grapes to produce concetrated amounts of flavors, aromas and colors, the first step to producing flavorful, complex wine.

Piattelli practices sustainable farming. All grapes are handpicked and manually sorted and our Mendoza vineyards are USDA certified organic.



Cafayate Valley, Salta

The most northern wine area in Argentina, Salta claims the highest altitude vineyards in the world. Balanced by lower latitudes and higher altitudes, the mountainous terrains create a rain shadow, ensuring clear skies and low precipitation—pristine climate for quality viticulture.

Agrelo, Lujàn de Cuyo, Mendoza

One of Argentina's most important wine regions, where more than 80% of the country's wine is made. The high desert area receives less than 8 inches of rainfall per year and offers exceptional terroirs. The dry alluvial soils are part of the secret behind Mendoza's best wines, including Malbec.

Tupungato, West Valle de Uco, Mendoza

The northernmost sub-region of the Uco Valley lies at the foot of the Mt. Tupungato volcano, and is one of the highest peaks in Argentina. The altitude brings clarity of light, water and air and moderates the high temperatures associated with lower latitudes.

Originally founded by descendants of the Italian Piattelli family, and now owned by Jon and Arlene Malinski of Minnesota, the Mendoza vineyard and winery is the production hub for the majority of our varietals.

Located in the foothills of the Andes Mountains, our vineyards rely on irrigation from the pure waters melting from their snow-crested peaks, a significant aspect of what makes our wines exquisite.

Home to such award-winning wines as our Grand Reserve Malbec and Cabernet Sauvignon, produced from century-old vines, as well as Premium Reserve Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon and Chardonnay, our winery has a 40,000 case capacity. From grape-planting to harvesting to crush to fermenting to bottling, we attentively oversee every moment of our wine's crafting.




Premium Reserve Chardonnay
