AMERICAN SIGN LANGUAGE CLASSES

HASA teaches American Sign Language (ASL) using the highly successful and well-respected method, Signing Naturally. To encourage students to think in signs, students and instructors avoid using speech in the classroom. Interpersonal communication (not simply learning signs for English words) is emphasized. Students focus on functions of specific everyday interactions that range from inviting someone to sit down to more abstract communication, such as giving directions or problem solving. Grammar is learned in the context of these communications. An additional benefit of this non-verbal, conceptual approach is the development of a cross-cultural awareness of the Deaf community.

Please note: the same textbook is used for ASL 1, ASL 2 and ASL 3. Once purchased, it can be used for all levels.
