79%

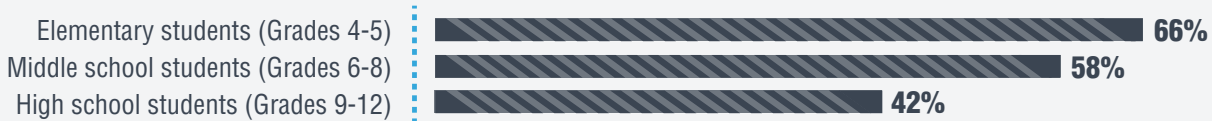

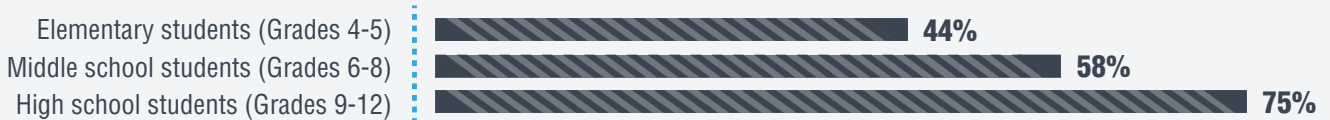
## Mobile Device Usage is High Among American Students

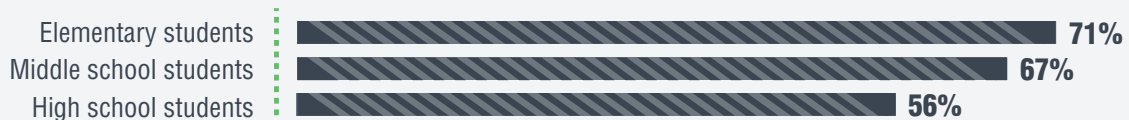
