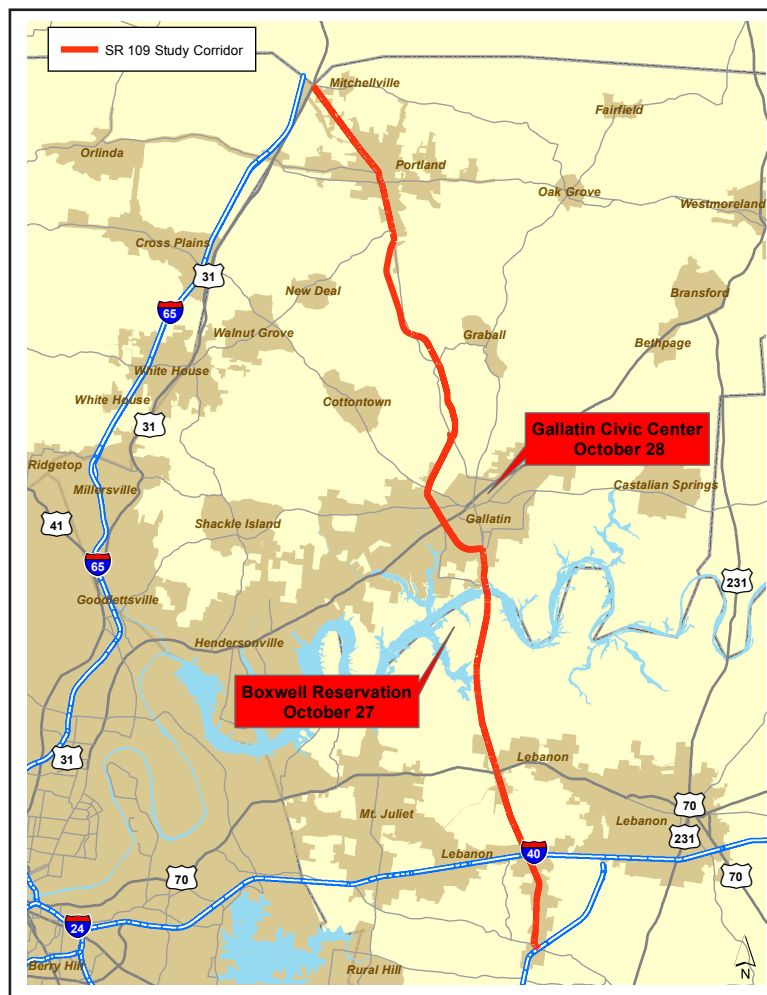
PURPOSE OF THE STUDY
