EASY STEPS

TO GET YOU ON YOUR WAY

1 APPLICATION PROCESS

- Apply online at apistudyabroad.com
- Pay US\$150 initial deposit (goes toward program fee and refunded if we are unable to place you)
- Submit supplemental application materials
 - Cover letter (explaining the internship you are seeking)
 - Résumé/CV
 - Two letters of reference
 - Official transcript/s
 - University contact form

2 PLACEMENT PROCESS

- Advising session to discuss learning and career objectives
- Pay confirmation payment of US\$400 (refunded if we are unable to place you)
- Submit Intent to Enroll (ITE) Form
- Overseas office begins customized placement process
- Confirmation of placement typically in 4-8 weeks

3 PRE-DEPARTURE PROCESS

- Accept your internship placement
- Pay program fee balance
- Read pre-departure materials via the @API online system
- Apply for immigration visa (where applicable)
- Book flights
- Receive housing assignment
- Depart!
