"It has been scientifically proven that service dogs reduce the stress hormones in children with autism," said Laura Sylvester, co-founder and director of <u>Good Dog! Autism Companions</u>. "We wanted Black Friday shoppers to experience the same stress reduction while we share our mission of how much a service dog can open up the world for a family living with autism."
