GreekGab is a labor of love for Kristin.

As a collegiate, Kristin was a Delta Gamma at the University of lowa where she served as house manager for her chapter. After graduation, she served as advisor board chair for the DG chapter at Drake University. A move to Kansas City connected her to more DGs and eventually she held positions (including advisory board chair and serving on house corporation board) for the Delta Gamma chapter at the University of Kansas for over eight years.

Her story took an unexpected turn when she was recruited to help turnaround the Sigma Alpha Epsilon fraternity chapter at KU following the death of a member, Jason Wren, in 2009. Working alongside SAE alums, KU administration, chapter members and other board volunteers, the chapter dwindled from 55 members to 15. For the next three years, Kristin and her team hired new staff, worked with chapter members and rebuilt relationships with the University of Kansas, and the Greek and Lawrence, Kansas communities. In 2012, the chapter house underwent a major remodeling and now houses 70+ members. Kristin also served on a task force to create the first ever "Greek standards" program, designed to improve overall chapter performance across four councils at KU. She was recently appointed to the national SAE Sexual Assault Ad Hoc committee.

In her real life, Kristin works with professional services firms to help them build their brands and public relations. She's also a fanatical tennis player, can cast a fly rod and loves playing with her wheaten terriers, Giada and Puck. She's also on the board of the Women's Foundation of Greater Kansas City.
