First report in three years uncovers state of CICS in the modern enterprise

BOISE, Idaho – January 27, 2015 – H&W Computer Systems (H&W) today announced the release of the first report in three years exploring the state of CICS, which is a central mainframe component. The report contains findings about the importance of CICS today, developing trends, and what the future holds.

“Many of the best-known businesses worldwide rely on CICS, which according to IBM processes 1.1 million transactions per second, in comparison with Google searches at only about 59,000 per second,” says Matt Link, president of H&W. “Because CICS is so important, our company is publishing this report to share gathered insights with the people who count on CICS every day to conduct their operations.”
