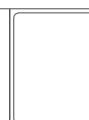

According to the recent reports, the prevalence of HIV drug resistance has been around 7% between the years 2003 and 2010 worldwide. With the expansion of Anti retroviral therapy (ART) coverage achieved over the recent years, increasing prevalence of HIV drug resistance has been reported, particularly to Non-Nucleoside Reverse Transcriptase Inhibitors (NNRTI). Reports suggest that 10-17% of naïve HIV patients in Australia, Japan, United States and Europe are infected with resistant viral strains to at least one of the ART agents. At the end of 2008, an estimated 1,178,350 persons aged ≥13 years were living with HIV infection, including 236,400 (20.1%) whose infections had not been diagnosed in USA.

Overall sales in the global influenza market were worth \$5.3 billion in 2007, which declined to \$3.7 billion in 2008, then increased to an estimated \$5.5 billion in 2009. By 2014, it is projected to increase to \$6.3 billion, for a 5-year CAGR of 2.7%. The largest segment of the market, vaccines, was valued at \$2.8 billion in 2008; this is expected to increase to \$3.2 billion in 2009, and is projected to reach \$4.2 billion in 2014, for a 5-year CAGR of 5.6%. Sales in the therapeutics market amounted to \$701 million in 2008, increased to an estimated \$2.1 billion in 2009, and are expected to fall to \$1.9 billion in 2014, for a 5-year CAGR of -2.4%.

The results of CRESIB's public health research are expected to guide development of new prevention strategies and to strengthen the application of strategies shown to be effective.
