Our Vision

The mission of Piedmont City Schools is to provide a quality education through shared responsibility in a safe supportive environment for all students to meet the challenges of a global society.

Piedmont is a small, rural city in northeastern Alabama with a population of ~5000

History and Context

Under Superintendent Matt Akin’s leadership, the district started the mPower Piedmont initiative in 2009 and provided all students grades 4-12 with both a laptop and internet access. Building on that initiative, and with the support of an NGLC grant, Piedmont kicked off mBolden Piedmont to bring mastery-based blended learning to the district, starting with the 275 students in the middle school.

Model Description

mBolden Piedmont is designed to meet 3 main goals: advanced mastery, relevance, and student ownership. Students will demonstrate mastery through hands-on projects, original creations, and experiments. The schedule includes Class Time, Goal Time, and My Time to allow for true individualized learning. Students work closely with mentors to focus on career and personal interests, exposing students to opportunities and creating connections between education and their futures.

Results

Piedmont Middle School saw tremendous growth from the fall to winter administration of the NWEA. In every grade level, for both math and reading, students grew at least 25% more than the national norm expectations for growth. On average, grades 6-8 reading scores grew 66% more than expected, while math scores grew 35% more than expected! 6th grade reading saw unbelievable results, growing twice what was expected in a short period of time.
