Boston, MA – PetPace, a revolutionary new smart collar that allows owners and veterinarians to continuously monitor pets’ health, is pleased to announce that the advanced monitors are now available in Canada.

“PetPace is the most sophisticated and richly-featured pet health monitor on the market. Designed for use on dogs and cats over 8 lbs., PetPace uses non-invasive sensors to accurately and continuously monitor temperature, pulse, respiration, activity levels, calories and more throughout the day. The data, accessible to pet parents and veterinarians via desktop computer or smartphone app, is also analyzed by a proprietary cloud-based engine that examines individual historical and breed-specific attributes. If the collar detects any abnormalities, a text alert is sent in real-time to owners and veterinarians, allowing for prompt attention and treatment of the issue.

“When you love something as much as owners love their pets, having your finger on the pulse of their health – literally - is of the utmost importance,” said Dr. Asaf Dagan, Chief Veterinarian for PetPace. “PetPace closes the communication gap between pets, owners, and vets - enabling pets, for the first time, to ‘tell’ us how they feel. Developed in cooperation with expert veterinarians, the PetPace collar and its data are also intended for use by veterinarians to aid in both in-hospital monitoring and follow-up monitoring after discharge from the hospital.
