### What's the Eugene Children's Film Festival?

The Eugene Children's Film Festival is an opportunity for all students to present their short films and/or videos to an audience. It's a celebration of art and technology and our young local filmmakers. Students and youth will submit a 3 minute short film from one of the ten selected categories for 2015 and enter for chance to be selected as one of the ten films shown during the day of the film festival at the Shedd Institute on August 29th.

#### Who Can Submit a Film?

As long as you are affiliated with a K-12 school or home school program, you can submit a film. This year we're accepting submissions from all ages. The person submitting the film must have the sole role of production of the film/video. We also have a parent help category we're calling the "Hand Holding" category, where parents can assist in helping their child who may be interested in participating in the filmmaking process, but not quite self-efficient enough to do it alone.

### Film Categories?

There are ten categories that you can choose to submit a film. Choose one of the following categories to base your film on.

- 1. Pet
- 2. Go Pro
- 3. Original Music Video/ Music Performance Documentary
- 4. Sport
- 5. Outdoors / Nature
- 6. Family Vacation / Travel
- 7. Visual Effects
- 8. Stop Motion or Animation

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- 9. Grab Bag Category if your film doesn't fall into any of the categories
- 10. Hand Holding Parent Involved Category

Please upload your video to Youtube or Vimeo. When your final draft is ready for review send the link to <u>info@aacfoundation.org</u>. Once the video has been reviewed we will ask for a digital copy to add to our Vimeo or Youtube Channel.

Your submission should include the following:

- 1. A completed application form online at www.aacfoundation.org with a parent or guardian signature.
- 2. Then submit your film online via *Youtube* or *Vimeo* and email the link to <u>info@aacfoundation.org</u> with a subject line Heading: Film Festival Submission
- 3. It's free! There is no cost to submit a film.
