Introducing the Basics: Guess and Check

Summarize the task as to a student problem to be more relatable. If you are a teacher, you can also make this more relatable by showing the student and example from the teacher's own life. For example, if the teacher has 15 pencils and wants to share them equally among 3 students, how many pencils would each student receive? The teacher can then ask the student to solve the problem using the guess and check strategy.
