PERKINS EASTMAN ANNOUNCES EXPANSION OF SAN FRANCISCO OFFICE TO NEW DOWNTOWN LOCATION

The new office occupies the entire 23rd floor of the 25-floor tower—also known as the Equitable Life Building—which was designed by American architect William Peugh and completed in 1955.

The new space will bring together in one location the firm's full San Francisco staff, which upon the merger with Lee, Burkhart, Liu (LBL Architects) at the beginning of 2015 brought the total employee count in San Francisco to 60 people. It also positions the firm for continued growth throughout 2015 and into 2016.
