THE STANDARD DEFINES...

- Data fields, tables and relationships therein
- ✓ REST API's or CSV templates to be used to deliver data
- Secure authentication/security provisions regarding the REST API's

THE STANDARD IS...

- An open technology standard developed collaboratively by industry leaders
- An accepted set of CSV templates and REST APIs to deliver data
- Freely available for school districts and providers at oneroster.org
- Increasingly adopted by large and small publishers and platforms

THE STANDARD IS NOT...

- Tied to any one publisher or platform provider's methodology
- A "pay for access" model that requires publishers to pay license fees to data holders and then charge school districts to recover those same license fees
- An actual software application
