and one million school meals delivered to children in need.

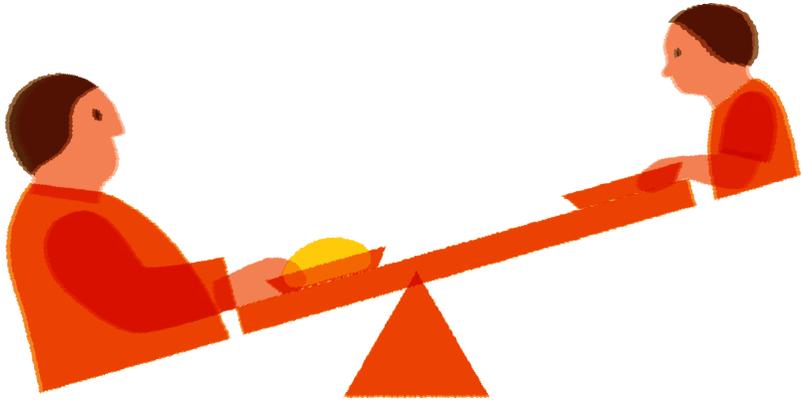
Make a difference by eating healthy. Let’s have a meal connected to the world.

TABLE FOR TWO is a social movement that originally started in Japan, and we strive to simultaneously address food-related challenges such as obesity and hunger.

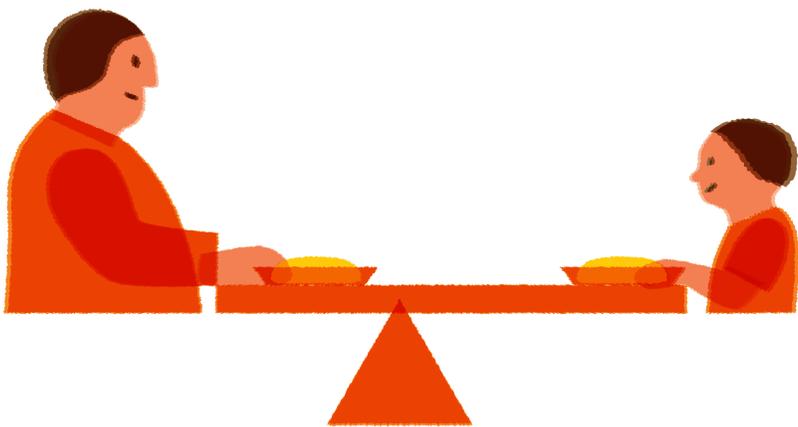

This World Food Day, Eat **Healthy Food** and Bring **a Warm Meal** to a Child in Need.

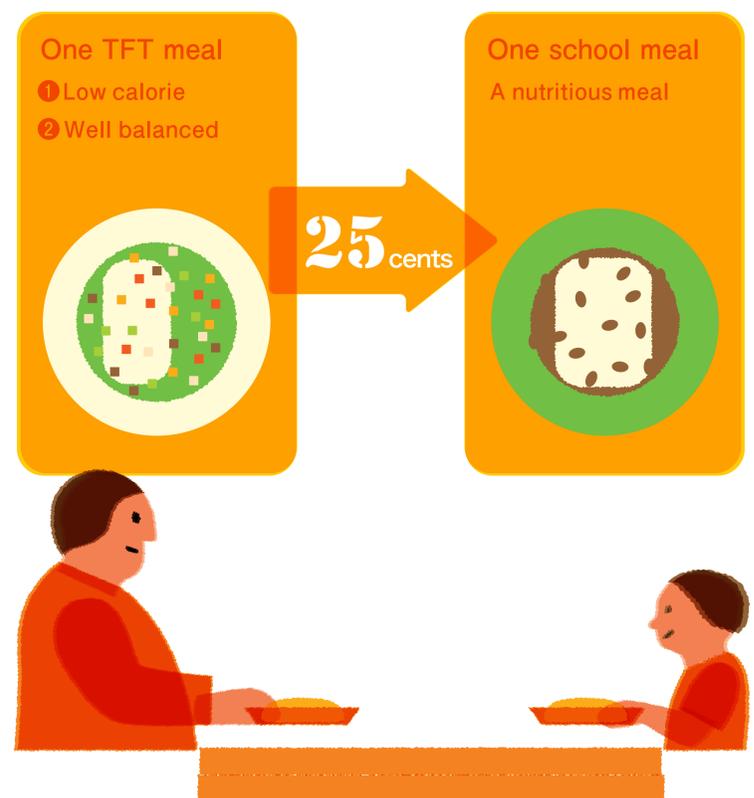
