The Hanover Theatre to Host Deepak Chopra, Co-Author of the Soon-to-be-Released Book "Super Genes"

(November 5, 2015) Deepak Chopra MD, FACP, founder of The Chopra Foundation and co-founder of The Chopra Center for Wellbeing, is due to appear at The Hanover Theatre for the Performing Arts on Wednesday, November 11 at 7:30PM.
