After developing new ideas, individuals and businesses are faced with a critical question: should they protect those ideas by keeping them secret or should they seek patent protection, which requires publishing the ideas to others. Trade secrets provide protections to those who take adequate steps to protect the secrecy of the information. This webinar discusses the nuts and bolt of trade secret protection, including what constitutes a trade secret, how to maintain trade secrets, and what to do when/if your trade secrets are stolen.
