PERKINS EASTMAN ANNOUNCES EXPANSION OF WASHINGTON, DC, OFFICE TO NEW DOWNTOWN LOCATION

Washington, DC (January 22, 2016) The executive committee of top international design and architecture firm Perkins Eastman is pleased to announce that the firm's Washington, DC, office has moved to a new space at One Thomas Circle. The new office occupies the second and third floors, including an outdoor terrace, of the 12-story building, which was completed in 1982 and renovated to meet LEED-Gold certification in 2003.

Upon the relocation of the staff of ForrestPerkins—which formally joined Perkins Eastman at the start of 2016—the total employee count in Perkins Eastman's Washington, DC, office will be 120 people.
