NuEyes and New England Low Vision & Blindness Announce Exclusive Partnership to Sell NuEyes

Worcester, MA (May 23, 2016) – NuEyes, a pioneer in the field of low vision technology, and New England Low Vision and Blindness (NELV&B), New England's largest supplier of low vision and blindness assistive devices, today announce an exclusive partnership to bring NuEyes wireless, wearable CCTV headset to visually impaired users across New England.

NuEyes is the newest head-mounted, hands-free wearable technology that makes CCTV and text-tospeech capabilities available in an easy-to-use headset about the size of a pair of sunglasses. NuEyes featuring ODG smartglasses magnify (up to 12x) and display enhanced versions of anything that a user looks at.

NuEyes and New England Low Vision and Blindness' shared vision for this partnership is to give people with vision loss in New England access to wireless hand-free magnification technology that can be used anywhere to increase their mobility, independence and quality of life.

Before NuEyes, people with vision loss had to rely on heavy desktop magnifiers that offer great magnification but no portability, or they had to use handheld devices that were portable, but lacked stability and kept their hands tied up with holding and maneuvering the device.

For years, Mark Greget, Chief Executive Officer and Founder of NuEyes, heard people with vision impairments ask for magnification technology to be put into a pair of glasses, until finally he decided to build a solution on the ODG Smartglasses platform.

NuEyes wearable technology is the first and only magnification device that is completely wireless, handsfree and mobile so users can have magnification and complete freedom without having to stop and fiddle with bothersome wires and control buttons.

NuEyes uses an HD (High Definition) digital camera mounted on the center bridge of eyeglass frames to stream images to built-in 3D stereoscopic HD display lenses. The full HD camera can shoot 1080p resolution at 60 frames per second. The camera image is projected onto the frame-mounted displays. NuEyes enlarges and enhances images captured by the camera on the inside of the glasses' lenses to help people with vision loss see better.

"We are thrilled to exclusively offer this cutting-edge technology to people with vision loss in New England," says Scott Krug, President of New England Low Vision and Blindness. "NuEyes is a pioneering solution for wearable mobile wireless magnification. There is nothing like it on the market."

NuEyes uses technologies originally designed by ODG (Osterhout Design Group) for military use. These smartglasses are a visual prosthetic that combines NuEyes' lenses and proprietary software with ODG's augmented reality (AR) R-7 smartglasses to enable people with severe vision loss to see again.

When most people think of augmented reality smartglasses, they typically think of online gamers or even the military with highly specialized glasses to help them perform high risk missions. NuEyes takes this technology and applies it to the specific needs of people with low vision.

More than just magnification glasses, NuEyes featuring ODG smartglasses has a complete on-board Android computing system that can be upgraded and expanded. NuEyes can connect to Wi-Fi for internet browsing, email and social media—all displayed directly onto the headset. This system also features an Apps store where users can download apps and customize their device to their specific personal needs.
