### Children's Miracle Network Hospitals

- Children's Miracle Network Hospitals is a charity that raises funds and awareness for 170 children's hospitals across the U.S. and Canada
  - Children's hospitals rely on community donations to provide crucial services
  - Donations stay local for hospitals to use them however they're needed most — typically for critical treatments and services, medical equipment, research and charitable care
  - U.S. member hospitals provide \$3.4 billion in charitable care annually

### Champions

- CMN Hospitals selects a pediatric patient from every state, Washington, D.C. and Puerto Rico, to serve as a "Champion" ambassador to advocate for the charitable needs of children's hospitals
- The Champions represent the 10 million kids treated at member CMN Hospitals every year
- This year marks the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Champions program

  - their inspiring stories
  - the important work going on at children's hospitals
