Probuphine is an implant, and circumvents the usual shortcomings of other Buprenorphine delivery options, greatly reducing the risk of overdose, misuse and dependence. The new implant also gives hope for those searching for options to get off methadone or Vivitrol shots.

Probuphine is an implant, and therefore keeps the low-dose of medication constant and steady. There is no fluctuation, which greatly decreases the risk of overdose or dependence. The implant option also nulls the issue of the patient forgetting to take their medication daily, or the risk that it may be lost, or stolen. One implant
