Through *Dark Side of the Full Moon,* Fura and Silliman uncover the history, origins, and mythology surrounding the dark side of being a mom, and attempt to reconstruct the idea of "motherhood", while forging a way to find the best system of care for women to find the help they need with ease, without shame, and with a quick recovery.

The feature-length documentary tells the intimate story of maternal mental health complications like pregnancy and postpartum mood and anxiety disorders and psychosis and the failings within the medical community to effectively screen, refer, and treat the more than 1.3 million mothers suffering each year in the United States. Dark Side of the Full Moon has been screened over 800 times and seen by thousands. It is now a tool used by teaching universities, county health departments, hospitals, childbirth educators, mental health specialists, nurses, lactation specialists, doulas and midwives.
