

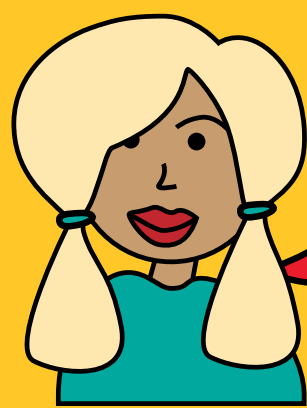

KNOW YOUR SCHOOL BUS SAFETY

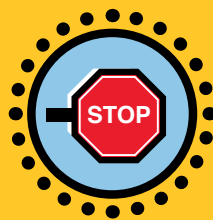


Why do I need to get to my stop early?

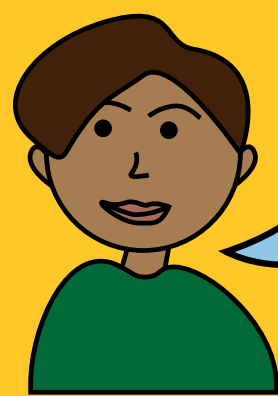


When you rush, you may not follow traffic safety rules. Play it safe and leave plenty of time.

Staying away from the busy road is always a good idea. But it also lets your driver see you clearly when pulling up to your bus stop.

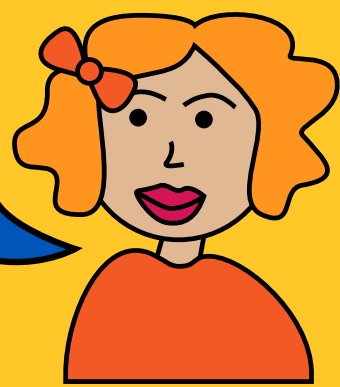


I want to talk to my friends. Why is being loud such a big deal?

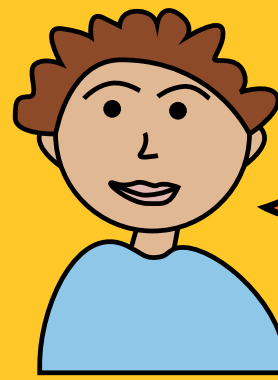


Talk and laugh quietly with your friends. Your bus driver needs to clearly hear sirens and notifications over the bus radio while focusing on the road.

What if I see a student getting bullied on the bus?



Just like school, your bus is a bully-free zone. Be sure to report any bullying to a trusted adult.

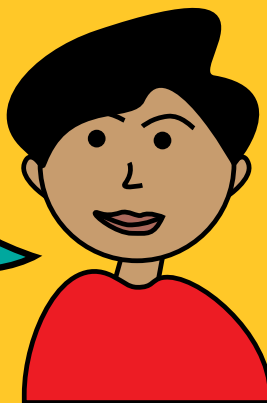


If something of mine rolls under the bus, can I grab it?



NEVER try to pick up anything from underneath or near the bus and wheels. Ask the driver for help first.

Why can't I get out of my seat when the bus is moving?



You could fall or get hurt while the bus is moving. Staying seated, with your feet and backpacks out of the aisle, keeps everyone safe.
