SAVANNAH DEVELOPMENT AND RENEWAL AUTHORITY TO HOST FORMER CHARLESTON MAYOR JOE RILEY FOR SAVANNAH URBANISM SERIES

The free event will take place on Thursday, October 20, 2016 at The Savannah Theatre (222 Bull Street) from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

The second installment of the Savannah Urbanism Series, **Building Beauty in the Urban Environment** will explore how sound planning and preservation can foster an engaging city fabric and create economic growth and better quality of life for the people therein. By sharing his insights and decades of experience, Mr. Riley will demonstrate how political leadership and individual stakeholders alike can enhance our infrastructure and public spaces and refine our strategies for development in the future.
