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The Choir of St. Peter in Chains Cathedral ♦

Anthony J. DiCello, artistic director

The Choir of Saint Peter in Chains Cathedral provides musical leadership at 11 a.m. Sunday Mass from mid-September through mid-June, at Christmas and Holy Week, and at special archdiocesan events. The choir, made up of some 18-24 professional singers, provides a wide range of liturgical choral music of all periods of the Catholic tradition from Gregorian chant through the 21st century. Two of its most anticipated performances each year are the Advent Service of Lessons and Carols on the first Sunday of Advent and the Tenebrae service the Wednesday evening of Holy Week.

Concerts are presented each year, often with orchestra as part of the Great Music in a Great Space. Membership in the cathedral choir is open to trained singers through audition. Recently appointed as music director for the Catholic Archdiocese of Cincinnati.

ANTHONY DICELLO has served as music director for the Cathedral of St. Peter in Chains since 1994. He oversees the cathedral's entire music program, including the cathedral's Great Music in a Great Space choral concert series. From 1984 to 2016, DiCello also served as director of music and assistant professor of music and pastoral studies at the Athenaeum of Ohio-Mount St. Mary's Seminary and as director of the Athenaeum Chorale.

A native of Wellsville, Ohio, he received his musical training at Youngstown State University, where he also served as an adjunct professor of music. Former positions have included director of music at St. Columba Cathedral in Youngstown and director of music for the Diocese of Dallas and Holy Trinity Seminary.

He is a member of the Conference of Roman Catholic Cathedral Musicians, a national organization serving cathedral musicians of the United States and Canada. He also serves on the group's steering committee.

DiCello is a member of the National Association of Pastoral Musicians, from whom he organized and chaired the first Standing Committee for Seminary Music Educators. He has presented various workshops and conducted choir festivals at national and regional conventions. In 2008 he was named NPM's Pastoral Musician of the Year for his outstanding leadership in pastoral music ministry.

In the Cincinnati archdiocese, he serves on the archdiocesan music committee, where he has presented numerous workshops, training sessions and choir festivals. ■
