England Rugby and Champagne Bollinger renew long term partnership

November 2016, London, UK – The Rugby Football Union (RFU) has announced it has renewed its long-term partnership with Champagne Bollinger. The four-year agreement will see Champagne Bollinger continue as the Official Champagne of England Rugby until 2020.
