



## **Fact Sheet about Mental Illness**

- One in five Americans will be diagnosed with a mental illness in their lifetime.
- 43.8 million American adults will experience a mental illness in any given year.
- 75 percent of people with mental illness report experiencing stigma.
- Psychiatric disorders are the leading cause of disability in the United States.
- 40 million adults in the United States are affected by anxiety
- Anxiety Disorders are the most common mental illness in the U.S.
- 355 million people worldwide have depression, making it one of the most common disorders in the world.
- 50 percent of all lifetime cases of mental illness begin by age 14 and 75
  percent begin by age 24.
