"We have the feel of a cozy care-home, but we are a licensed center," Hamdan said. "The difference is we are all single story, we have no long hallways or confusing elevators. But we have all the amenities of the big centers — the activities, culinary department, wellness department and transportation. This is like a bed-and-breakfast with 24/7 care."
