Our online initiative has garnered support from individuals in 168 countries, including Arab states and other nations that are fiercely critical of Israel. Although half a million signatures is a significant milestone, support for this historic undertaking continues to grow rapidly. We are marching towards true international awareness of the underlying issue: Israel's right to exist and the necessity of a strong and undivided Jerusalem as the foundation of the one and only Jewish homeland.

As Israel celebrates the 50th anniversary of the historic reunification of Jerusalem, we ask you to remind Israel's detractors at the United Nations, in Washington, DC, and wherever else you may encounter them, that Jerusalem is not merely a city, but an eternal symbol of the Jewish nation's deep roots in the Land of Israel. If the status of Jerusalem were to be called into question, the Jewish people's right to exist in Israel – and elsewhere – would immediately follow suit. **Jerusalem is our link to the past and our conduit to a bright future.**

The Jerusalem Declaration

We declare that Jerusalem is the eternal capital of the Jewish people and support all efforts to maintain and strengthen a united Jerusalem as the undivided capital of the State of Israel.

We, the undersigned, affirm that Jerusalem is the capital of the Jewish people and the State of Israel. No other national, political or religious entity has an equally legitimate moral, political or historical claim to Jerusalem as its sovereign capital.

The eternal connection between Jerusalem and the Jewish people is unbreakable. In Biblical times (11th century BCE), Jerusalem was established as the capital of Israel by King David. Ever since, there has been a formidable Jewish presence in the city whenever historically possible. The Jewish connection to Jerusalem has been overtly proclaimed throughout the centuries when Jews worldwide declare "Next year in Jerusalem."

We support free and open access to Jerusalem for all peoples and religions, under the sovereignty of the State of Israel, and reject returning Jerusalem's status to a divided city, such as existed between 1948 and 1967. During that time, Arabs controlled the eastern section of Jerusalem and forbade non-Muslims from accessing holy sites in eastern Jerusalem, including the Western Wall and the Temple Mount.

We, therefore, wish to thank Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and Jerusalem Mayor Nir Barkat for their strong support in maintaining Jerusalem as a unified capital city under Israeli rule. We ask both Mr. Netanyahu and Mr. Barkat, as representatives of the people of Israel, to continue to do everything in their power to maintain and strengthen a united Jerusalem for the benefit of the State of Israel, the Jewish people, and the citizens of the world.

We urge world leaders to recognize the unbreakable bond between the Jewish nation and Jerusalem and to guarantee that Jerusalem remains the undivided capital of the State of Israel.
