What is a HAHO jump?

HAHO stands for high altitude, high open. A HAHO jump is a special type of military-style parachute jump performed when an aircraft is unable to fly above enemy skies without creating a threat to jumpers or the plane. Jumpers exit at high altitude, quickly pull chutes, and fly under canopy to the designated target. Experienced HAHO jumpers can travel 30 or more miles by parachute.

Do I need any skydiving experience?

No. We specialize in tandem jumps.

How long will I fly under canopy?

The total time under canopy varies but you could spend 20 or more minutes in the air. The actual time is based on your comfort level and wind conditions.

Where do jumps take place? We jump from a skydive center located in Somerville, TN, less than an hour from Memphis, TN. We also sometimes offer jumps out of Lumberton, Mississippi, near New Orleans.

How much skydiving experience do I need to complete a tandem HALO jump? None.

We'll teach you everything you need to know to jump and land safely. (To jump solo, you must have a Class D license.)

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Is this safe? Skydiving is inherently risky. You could die. You will be required to sign a release of liability. That said, you'll be tightly strapped to an expert jumper and certified tandem master who will be using the best possible equipment and taking all steps humanly possible to make your adventure as safe as it can be.

What kind of plane is used? You'll jump from a specially modified B90 King Air.

What physical requirements must I meet? You must be in excellent health, weigh less than 230 lbs and not have had surgery within the past 18 months or donated blood within the past month.





You'll make your Tandem HALO Jump with men who began their skydiving careers in the military and as civilians, have gone on to achieve some of the highest ratings issued by the United States Parachute Association (USPA).

Jump Operations are under the command of Halojumper's Kevin Holbrook who has more than 30 years of skydiving experience and has logged over 7000 jumps.

How long is the freefall? HAHO jumps feature only seconds of freefall. Your chute will open early so you can fly under canopy for an extreme amount of time.

Can you describe the program? Plan to arrive at the jump zone in Somerville, TN by 11am on Sunday. You'll spend the entire afternoon getting fitted for equipment and training with our expert HALO/HAHO jump team. You'll finish your training in time for dinner. We recommend you stay somewhere nearby because you'll need to be back at the drop zone by 7:30 am on Monday morning. If all goes as scheduled, you'll have completed your incredible adventure by noon. Weather doesn't always cooperate, so please have Tuesday available as a back-up day. (One-day itineraries can be arranged.)

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Standard Tandem Jump: \$3695 per person

INCLUDES: Jump training, [HAHO tandem jump](#), use of flight suit, raw video of adventure, digital photos and certificate of completion. Hotel accommodations, meals and travel costs are not included in the price. Note: Tandem HAHO Skydives are available all year long but the best months for jumping are May through November.

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
