The enriched E Screen color line features eleven colors: Charcoal/Charcoal, Charcoal/Cocoa, Charcoal/Apricot, Charcoal/Grey, Charcoal/Grey-Stone, Pearl/Grey, Pearl/Pearl, Pearl/Linen, White/Linen, White/Pearl, and White/White.

E Screen delivers the complete solar control package: maximum transparency with excellent thermal and visual comfort. The modernized color palette provides clean aesthetics with an emphasis on classic and sophisticated pearl and grey color combinations. E Screen contributes towards improved light control, energy efficiency, and UV resistance with blockage ranges from approximately 90% to 99%. For commercial applications, the fabric also provides efficient acoustic control (in 1% openness) and serves as an excellent printing medium for promotional signage.

Comprised of fiberglass and vinyl for exceptional durability and performance, E Screen is tested to meet fire classifications NFPA 701-99 TM#1, California U.S. Title 19, and CAN/ULC-S109-03 Small & Large Flame Test. The fabric is also bacterial and fungal resistant, GREENGUARD Gold certified, and RoHS compliant.
