

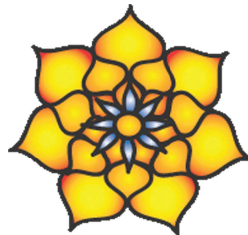

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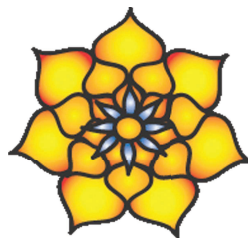

Catvāry Ārya Satyāni (Sanskrit)

Cattāri Ariyo Saccāni (Pali)

Chatuk Arei Sachak/ចតុអរិយសច្ចៈ (Khmer)

The Four Noble Truths (English)

Dukkha (ទុក្ខៈ: Suffering): All lives are subject to Dukkha

Cause of Dukkha (សមុទយៈ: Samudaya): Desire (តណ្ហា) is the root causes of Dukkha

Cessation of Dukkha (និរោធៈ: Nirhodha): Eliminate desire

Steps to eliminate desire (មគ្គៈ: Magga):

Apply the Noble Eightfold Path [Ārya Astanga Marga (Sanskrit)/Ariyo Aṭṭhaṅgiko Maggo (Pāli)]

- *Right Understanding*
- *Right Thought*
- *Right Speech*
- *Right Conduct/Action*
- *Right Livelihood*
- *Right Effort*
- *Right Attentiveness/Mindfulness*
- *Right Concentration/Meditation*

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
