Scartelli Olszewski P.C. Makes New Law in Pennsylvania Again

Five months ago, Pennsylvania lawyers Peter Paul Olszewski Jr and Melissa A. Scartelli achieved a PA Supreme Court victory requiring surgeons to get informed consent personally from their patients before undergoing surgery. ⁽¹⁾

Today, (November 29 2017) Attorney Olszewski gained another Pennsylvania Supreme Court victory - this time in criminal court. The court agreed with Olszewski that Pennsylvania's constitution requires police officers to obtain a search warrant or have exigent circumstances before seizing a vehicle from a residential driveway. This high court ruling expands the right of privacy for all Pennsylvania citizens. Olszewski's client, Daniel Loughnane is charged with leaving the scene of a fatal accident. ⁽²⁾

"The Supreme Court's Opinion is a tremendous victory for our client as well as for all citizens of Pennsylvania. For Mr. Loughnane, the Commonwealth is now prohibited from using illegally obtained evidence in trial. In the bigger picture, all Pennsylvanians now enjoy a significantly greater right of privacy in vehicles parked in their driveway." - Attorney Peter Paul Olszewski, Jr.
