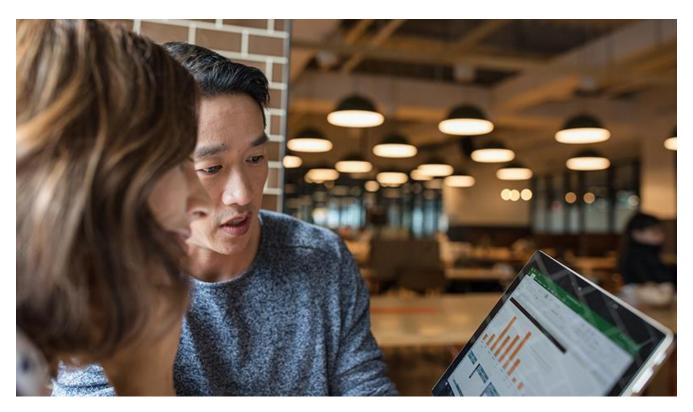


What is Microsoft 365 Business and Who is it for?

- Windows 10 Pro, including upgrades from Windows 7 and 8.1 Pro •
- A single console to manage user and device settings .
- Data protection controls on personal and company devices •
- Cyberthreat protection from malware, viruses, and spyware •
- Self-service PC deployment with Windows AutoPilot •
- 1TB of file storage •
- Microsoft StaffHub (See the next section) •

Microsoft 365 Business is the all-in-one Microsoft package for SMBs, previously only available to Enterprise customers. Throw in 24x7 online and phone support and 99.9% guaranteed uptime and it feels like a sweet deal for \$20/month per user.

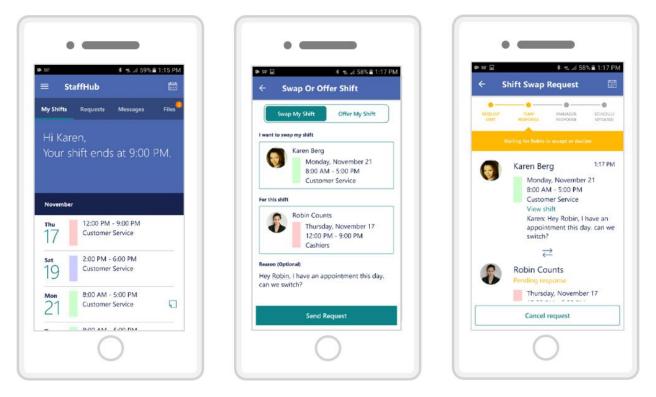
