Discussing Family Planning Issues

God and the Holy Spirit are very upset when a young adult gets an offer to use illegal drugs at a party or at a friend's house. Who teaches them to reject an offer to do dope and to reject that kind of negative peer pressure?

Do we have seminars in our schools that teach our young adults about the dangers of using illegal and recreational street drugs? Do we have counselors that tell our young adults the truth about what they will be facing if they accept an offer to begin using dope? Why is Substance Abuse Prevention Training not part of the curricula of so many different grammar schools and middle schools, high schools, and parochial high schools?

Does God have to teach young adults that illegal drugs are bad for them? Why are school not producing this kind of training for their students. Is it better to get lost as a career substance abuser and drug dealer than to avoid that fate if the student had been trained to reject drugs in his or her schools?

How many young adults understand what crystal meth is? How many young adults know what happens when we become addicted to pain killers on the streets? How many students know what it means to be in detox? What does it mean to be high on crack?

We can teach kids and young adults everything about God and the prophets. Why can we not teach them about the demons of substance abuse? Why do we allow the lives of our young adults to be destroyed because they do not know how to reject peers that want to do drugs?

We have to teach our kids and young adults not only to reject drug dealing peers but to also turn them into the police department for evaluation. Drug dealers and drug kingpins are bad peers. We must reject bad peers in order to make our communities safer for our families, our kids, our young adults, and for all of our students.

Young Adults and God's Love
