Every day, a different resident will water the garden and twice a month Patti will come back to the facility to lead various activities with the residents using the garden. The garden will also be used for various programs throughout the month including sensory stimulation. Based on scientific findings, the community expects to see a vast number of benefits with this garden therapy including increased independence in caring for living objects, a sense of purpose and accomplishment, as well as improvements in the sensory, social, physical, cognitive, and spiritual domains that Magnolias strives to enhance for those in their memory care facility.
