The KSO offers orchestral warmth with the area premiere of John Adams's Dr. Atomic Symphony, written from music taken from his 2005 opera about Robert Oppenheimer, the Manhattan Project and the creation of the atomic bomb. Dimitri Shostakovich's Symphony No. 11 (The Year 1905) may, for political cover, refer to a massacre by tsarist troops of innocent Russians, but the symphony was written in the aftermath of the Soviet invasion of Hungary in 1957.


## Singing in the Rain
