I, Frank Weyer, owner of Trademark Application Serial No. 78317588 for registration of the mark NYFIT (pronounced “nigh fit,” as in “nylon/spandex fitness clothing”) for “clothing, namely shirts,” in response to the Notice of Opposition filed by Fashion Institute of Technology (“F.I.T.”) dated August 16, 2005, and the Notice from the Trademark Office mailed August 17, 2005, hereby answer the notice and counterclaims as follows:

Counterclaim

15. I reallege the allegations of paragraphs 1 – 14 hereof.

16. I, Frank Weyer, am the owner of Trademark Application Serial No. 78317588 for registration of the mark NYFIT (pronounced “nigh fit,” as in “nylon/spandex fitness clothing”) for “clothing, namely shirts.”


17. Opposer, Fashion Institute of Technology, (“F.I.T.”) is a small special purpose community college that offers two year and four year degrees in fashion design and related subjects to a limited number of students.

18. F.I.T is known by its acronym, “F.I.T.,” pronounced “eff, eye, tea.”

19. F.I.T. is not known by the word “fit”, and has never used the word “fit” as a trademark for clothing.

20. F.I.T. is not entitled to the exclusive right to use the word “fit” in marks for clothing.


21. The word “fit” when used by itself for clothing is descriptive and is not entitled to registration on the principal register.

22. F.I.T. is the registered owner of trademark registration number 2,247,127 for the mark “FIT” for “clothing, namely, t-shirts, long-sleeved t-shirts, sweatshirts, sweatpants, hats, caps and headbands.”

23. To the extent that F.I.T. is alleging that its trademark registration number 2,247,127 for the mark “FIT” constitutes the word “fit,” then that registration is invalid on the basis of at least the following reasons: fraud in registering the mark, fraud in maintaining the registration of the mark, no use of the mark in commerce that may be regulated by the United States Congress, descriptiveness, and likelihood of confusion with dozens of preexisting registrations for marks for clothing that include the word “fit.”

WHEREFORE, I respectfully request that F.I.T.’s opposition be denied, that my application for registration of the trademark NYFIT be allowed, and that F.I.T.’s registration no. 2,247,127 for the mark “FIT” be cancelled.
