RESOLUTION ENDORSING LEGISLATION BY STATE REPRESENTATIVE WILLIAM GABIG BANNING TEACHER STRIKES IN PENNSYLVANIA

JULY 2006

WHEREAS, the provision of a thorough and efficient system of public education to serve the needs of the Commonwealth is a Constitutional requirement under Article III, Section 14 of the Pennsylvania State Constitution, and

WHEREAS, a strike in the public sector represents a strike against the public interest, and a public school employee strike represents an actionable breach of duty to members of the public living in that school district, and

WHEREAS, thirty-eight (38) states already prohibit public school teacher strikes, and

WHEREAS, Pennsylvania ranks #1 for teacher strikes having the worst record in the United States, with more teacher strikes than any other state, and

WHEREAS, in 2004, Pennsylvania had more strikes than all of the other forty-nine states combined, and

WHEREAS, tens of thousands of innocent students and their families are continually subjected to teacher strikes in Pennsylvania, including over 44,000 in 2005-2006 alone, and

WHEREAS, the average teacher's salary in Pennsylvania, \$53,200, is the highest in the country when adjusted for cost of living, and

WHEREAS, there is no empirical data to suggest that banning teacher strikes results in a poor deal for teachers, as seven out of the top ten states with the highest average salary prohibit teacher strikes, and

WHEREAS, compulsory interest binding arbitration as a mechanism to resolve school employee contract disputes is a violation of Article III, Section 31 of the Pennsylvania State Constitution, and

WHEREAS, compulsory interest binding arbitration as a mechanism to resolve school employee contract disputes is a violation of taxpayer rights, by empowering unelected and unaccountable arbitrators to set, control, or otherwise influence school taxes, and

WHEREAS, compulsory interest binding arbitration as a mechanism to resolve school employee contract disputes is a violation of the civil rights of non-union school employees by empowering unelected arbitrators to overrule the wishes of a democratically elected employer, and impose compulsory union dues (agency shop) on all school employees, and

WHEREAS, the state teachers' union (PSEA) has annual revenues of approximately \$84 million, 178,000 members, and spends millions of dollars on political activity and lobbying, with lobbyists being paid upwards of \$130,000 per year, and

WHEREAS, approximately 3,800 non-union teachers are forced to pay money to the PSEA as a condition of their employment, and

WHEREAS, current law allows Pennsylvania teachers to strike and disrupt the educational process without any risk of financial harm to striking teachers, adding to the rapid escalation of educational costs by creating an environment where school boards must choose between further harm to students or irreparable financial harm to the community.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that the undersigned leaders of taxpayer associations on behalf of their memberships across Pennsylvania, by their signatures, strongly support and endorse legislation proposed by State Representative William Gabig, making teacher strikes illegal in Pennsylvania, including financial penalties for any public school employee or labor union that violates the law, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the undersigned leaders of taxpayer associations on behalf of their memberships across Pennsylvania, by their signatures, DEMAND that the Legislature immediately and without hesitation sponsor and support the bill proposed by Representative Gabig, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the undersigned leaders and their members strongly OPPOSE any legislation based on resolving teacher contract disputes through compulsory binding arbitration.
