2007 Interop New York Attendee Survey

Key Findings

- 1) **On a scale of 1-5 (1 being not important and 5 being very important), how important are the following issues to your team?**
- 2) **For the following IT solutions and issues, please indicate whether/when your organization is planning on implementing them.**

VIRTUALIZATION MANGAGEMENT

1. 75% say that virtualization management is important to their operations. Of that 75%, 39% say that virtualization is very important to their operations.
2. 35% already have tools in place for virtualization management. 48% plan to implement this technology by next year.

DASHBOARDS/OPERATIONAL BUSINESS INTELLIGENCE

1. 63% say that Dashboards/Operational Business Intelligence is important to their organizations.
2. 22% of respondents report they currently have tools in place and 53% say they plan to implement in the next year.

ITIL/CMDB

1. ITIL is not a priority for respondents with nearly 60% citing it as middle to low importance.
2. 38% are planning to implement some form of solution by next year. 48% had no plans to implement or didn't know. Only 14% actually had tools in place to support this.

IT ASSET MANAGEMENT/INVENTORY

1. IT Asset Management/Inventory is important to 82% of those surveyed. Of that 82%, 55% say that virtualization management is very important to their operations.
2. 36% already have tools in place for IT Asset Management/Inventory and another 1/2 planning to implement by next year.

MULTI-VENDOR DATABASE MONITORING

1. 58% of respondents say that multi-vendor database monitoring is an integral part of their IT operations.
2. While Multi-Vendor Database Monitoring ranked high on the scale of importance (58%), it ranked low on tools in place with only 20%.

SECURITY INFORMATION MANAGEMENT

1. 83% say that security information management is important to their operations.
2. Only about a third of respondents already have a security information management tools in place, with another 50% reporting plans to implement by next year.

IPV6

1. IPv6 is not a priority with 73% of respondents ranking it at middle to low priority.
2. Of those answered, only 8% have tools to support IPV6 in place, with another 29% having plans to implement by next year. An overwhelming 63% have no plans to implement tools and 20% didn't know.
