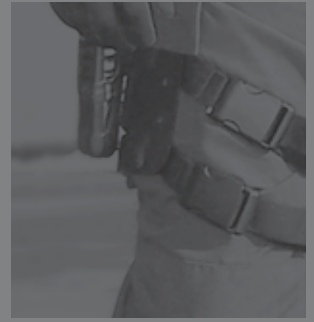




# COVENANT CANINE TRAINING AND OPERATIONS

Covenant's canines are selected from numerous vendors both in the U.S. and abroad. Once a canine has passed our rigorous testing, it is then trained for its chosen application using sound methods that incorporate successive approximation and positive reinforcement techniques. Our odor recognition imprinting (narcotics or explosives) incorporates real substances licensed to us by the DEA and ATF. Our odor imprinting and environmental training also utilizes methods which translate into a strong social canine that can quickly be trained with an experienced handler and put to work in a variety of operational environments.

## COVENANT CANINE HANDLERS

All Covenant Canine Handlers are subjected to a comprehensive background screening process. All Handlers have a minimum of two years experience as either a military or law enforcement Canine Handler. Many of our Canine Handlers possess every level of DOD or DOE clearances. Our explosive detector teams are certified biannually and conform to industry standards. All canines are certified utilizing an ATF "odor recognition proficiency test" as well as an operational/practical evaluation that will exceed typical law enforcement canine certification standards. Covenant Canine can train and validate to any standard that the client may request.



## COVENANT CANINE TRAINING CENTER A WORLD CLASS CANINE TRAINING CENTER

The Covenant Canine Training Center (CCTC), located just outside of the National Capital Region in Leesburg, Virginia, can house and train student Handlers on site. We also have a full-service kennel within the CCTC-22 acre site. The Center is complete with furnished bedrooms and personal workstations. The Center is available with wireless internet services, phone, and common areas with television. The boarding area has a full-service kitchen for meal preparation. The Center houses a complete conference/classroom and onsite kenneling with training areas in the surrounding suburban area.



## COVENANT CANINE HANDLER COURSE CURRICULUM

All Canine Handlers that attend training at the Covenant Canine Training Center will be trained both in the classroom and with their canine at several of our off-site training venues. Covenant Canine incorporates a 28 section curriculum into the training platform. Once a curriculum subject is taught in the classroom the student handler is then trained in a practical application setting with his or her canine. All Canine Handlers will learn the importance of numerous topics including but not limited to; First Aid, ethics, liability issues, record keeping, standardization and certification, survival tactics, environmental-specific searches narcotics/explosives recognition and handling, and many others. All student handlers are tested on the presented material, validated with their canine, and certified through Covenant's certification process. All aspects of the course are documented, digitally taped and retained for liability purposes.



## COVENANT CANINE EXPLOSIVES DETECTION CANINE SERVICES

Covenant Canine can provide trained and certified single- or dual-purpose explosive detection canines for continuous contract site operations. These canines are imprinted and trained at Covenant Canine to detect a minimum of 22 different explosives' odors in five different groups. Many of these explosives are consistent with current data compiled by the FBI Bomb Data Center. Any canine produced at Covenant Canine can be tailor-trained to locate any environmentally-specific odor at the client's request. All Explosives Detection Canine Teams are certified through the ATF Odor Recognition Proficiency Test, as well as an operational/practical evaluation that exceeds typical law enforcement canine certification standards. All of the detection canines from Covenant Canine will be socially sound and guaranteed through a stringent validation process, as well as third-party evaluations upon request. All canines are routinely trained using a variety of environmental areas including: vehicles, buildings, open areas, luggage, packages and parcels, shipping containers, aircraft, and numerous others.
