Dr. James Rota received his DDS with honors from the Loyola University, in Chicago, Illinois. He earned the coveted CN Johnson Award for Clinical Excellence. Dr. Rota became an Associate Professor at UCLA in 1963 and assisted in the development of the UCLA Dental School.

Dr. Rota, a pioneer in Dental Ergonomics, developed many work simplification standards now practiced by dentists as common procedure, including Four-Handed Dentistry. He also helped develop the protocols for safe mercury removal from the mouth, which are commonplace in Biological Dentistry today.

Dr. Rota has lectured and has presented his research in dental ergonomics internationally. He is an accredited member of the International Academy of Oral Medicine and Toxicology.

Currently, Dr. Rota maintains a private practice in Los Angeles, California.

Dr. Gruenn received his medical degree from the University of Heidelberg, Germany in 1978, where he completed his residency in Internal Medicine and his fellowship in Psychosomatic Medicine. After moving to the U.S., Dr. Gruenn underwent his postgraduate training at LA County/USC, and became licensed to practice medicine in the state of California in 1993.

Dr. Gruenn's professional experience in Europe and the U.S. puts him at the forefront of Integrative and Preventative Medicine. He utilizes a wide variety of innovative therapies including Heavy Metal Detoxification, Hormone Replacement, Antioxidant and Nutrient Therapies.
